Dear Friends,

Council NEWS

Dear Church Family,

Summer is kicking into high gear and so is St. Paul's! At our June Council meeting this past Thursday we reviewed all the activity that has been set in motion by initiatives the Council and the BOCE have approved, as it is important we take stock and ensure things are proceeding on track. I thought it might be helpful if I reviewed some of this with you, as well.

One of the initiatives, coordinated with the BOCE, that is very visible to you has been the hiring and subsequent activities of our three directors—Program Director (Kelly Akerberg), Youth Director (Jasmine Becker), and Preschool Director (Becky Lucking)—or the Dynamic Trio as I like to call them. The Dynamic Trio is supported by our talented Office Manager (Lena Vocalino), who works together with them to coordinate communications in print and on social media. In addition to each of their specific roles, they have been combining their talents to put on programs that involve a range of audiences and interests. So far, the Casa Road Rally, the Potluck, and the Imagination Garden events have attracted people of all ages and introduced potential new members of St. Paul's to the vitality of our church community. Upcoming events, like the Bike Swap, Ice Cream Social, and the Rally Day Picnic will similarly have broad appeal. And as Pastor Greg mentioned at a recent Sunday service, he is planning a special Prayer Vigil service and Kelly has reached out to other churches in our community inviting them to join us. We are excited to see what unfolds. Last but not least, Jasmine, the BOCE, and our Kids Konnect teachers, have successfully launched our Super Summer Sunday program for our young children, which meets every Sunday except the first Sunday of the month during our Sunday worship service following the Young Christians Message.

Another initiative is the relaunch of our Preschool (rebranded as St. Paul's Guiding Light Preschool), under Becky's extraordinary leadership and the supervision of the Preschool Board. Becky has been hard at work attracting new families and their young children to our Preschool (and hopefully St. Paul's), with her energetic and creative behind-the-scenes activities. Becky's offering of a Christian Montessori early education program is generating great interest and there are least 8 enrollees signed up so far. As a demonstration of our confidence in the success of this program, the Council approved interim funding at its most recent meeting to bridge the gap until St. Paul's Guiding Light Preschool's term begins and tuition is collected in mid-August. We are so excited!

And finally, at least for now, I recently held a meeting with all of the existing committee chairs to gather their input and discuss how best to proceed with the transition to the proposed new Ministry structure. It was a constructive meeting and we all agreed on a roadmap for moving forward. Stay tuned!

As you can see, there is a lot of positive activity going on at St. Paul's. School may be out for summer, but your Council, St. Paul's staff, and St. Paul's many volunteers are not on vacation. They are hard at work! If you would like to get involved in any of the upcoming programs or new committees, or even on Council or the BOCE, please let me know. We welcome your participation!

McHenry County Now in High Risk Zone of CDC Covid-19 Community Levels



As you know, the Council has been monitoring the key risk metrics for McHenry County on an ongoing basis to assess whether the risk metrics in McHenry County meet acceptable levels of risk as set by IDPH and the CDC. As some of you may know, McHenry County recently entered the High level of community risk set by the CDC. At this level, the CDC recommends that individuals wear masks indoors in public and get tested if they have symptoms that might indicate a Covid-19 infection. You can find more information and check the county community level on an ongoing basis at https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/science/community-levels.html.

While mask wearing will remain optional, we thought it was important for you to be made aware of this heightened level of risk so that you could determine the appropriate precautions you wish to take depending on your individual circumstances. We continue to support and encourage mask wearing by anyone who feels for any reason that it is safer for them to do so. It remains a top priority to promote a safe and healthy environment for our congregation.
